- Approval of May 2020 minutes: Holly Brain made motion to pass, Amy Garff seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.
- Treasurer Report – Michelle Loosli
 - Budget presented \$14,700.00. Membership and donations have been reduced by half. Most everything on budget from last year reduced except graduation party and hospitality the same. No grant for graduation this year.
 - Budget approval: Michelle Loosli made motion to pass, Katrina Stucki seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.
- President's report, Committee reports and school updates/activities:
 - Teacher Liaison Report – Rob Scott:
 - Appreciate PTSA so much. Please keep in mind that teachers are stressed right now.
 - Students can still do the ACT with free voucher. They need to contact counseling center. ACT for April, will forward testing dates.
 - SBO, Legislative, Leadership reports to present next month.

 - GREAT Lunch will be on hold for now due to Covid. Mitch Nerdin talked about how tough this can be for the kids right now. Need to eliminate gatherings but also need to process and figure out social needs for the kids. Mitch Nerdin will check back with PTA on this.
 - Hospitality Report – Amy Garff: No group gatherings. Talked about holiday lunch, box lunches and maybe end of year lunch. Thank you so much for the Ice Cream party for the teachers for Back to School. Last year got t-shirts and gift cards for the end of year. Thank you for all your hard work on graduation last year.

- Principals' report:
 - Construction update: Was able to get last minute signs to direct for driving. 450 stalls on campus and using church parking lot on north end of campus. Grass on baseball fields and sidewalk is done. One month will bring in more re-locatables for next phase. 2024 is when building is supposed to be done.
 - PBL – changes district wide. Moved from a decay average to a recent average and only one assessment instead of three assessments.
